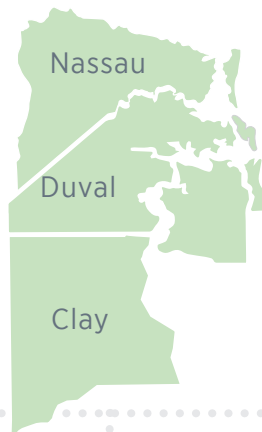

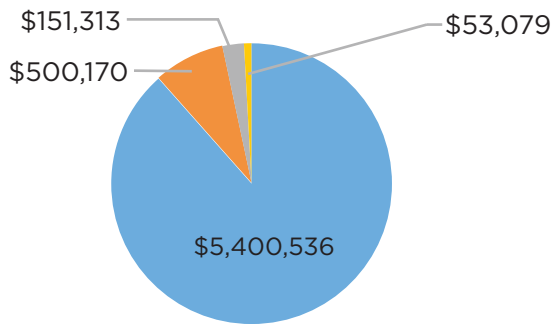
LENGTH OF TIME HOMELESS

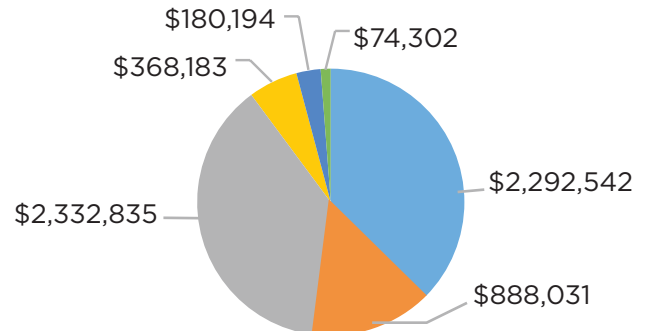
