2021 PIT COUNT Preliminary Numbers



The 2021 Point-in-Time (PIT) Count took place over the course of 3 days (Jan. 26 - 28) and focused primarily on unsheltered homelessness. Outreach teams and shelter workers conducted the count utilizing the *Counting Us* app.

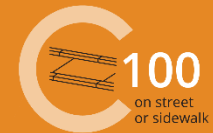




